The Community Clinic provides quality medical and dental care to people who live and work in our community.

About the Clinic

- We provide medical services to low income and uninsured individuals.
- We offer a wide range of medical services, including many specialties. And we have dental services on site.
- We accept both scheduled appointments and walk-ins.
- We are not a "Free Clinic." Patients pay for services on a sliding fee scale based on their ability to pay.
- We receive some funding from government and foundation sources.
- We rely on community and private donations to cover the difference.

Quality Medical Care

We provide a broad range of medical services and programs. We offer primary care for all ages as well as specialty care in selected areas.

Our providers include both paid and volunteer doctors, nurses and nurse practitioners. The quality of care we provide is excellent. For example, our success in diabetes and hypertension management is equal to and in most cases superior to that of major medical centers.

A Community Resource

Our patients come from all over South Orange County but many live or work in Laguna Beach.

Who are these people? They are the people who work in our local shops, hotels and restaurants. They are small business owners and artists. They are our household workers, gardeners and nannies. They are local teens that

need information or treatment for teen-specific issues. Our patients are all around and among us—members of our community—and they very much need the care we provide.

Although the majority of our patients are employed, most are living at or below the poverty level. They pay what they can afford for the services we provide. The Clinic covers the remainder of the cost of service with funds from other sources.

Special Services

We have many specialty providers on staff: cardiology, podiatry, pediatrics, orthopedics, endocrinology, obstetrics and gynecology, and others.

Our Teen Clinic serves the special needs of the young people in our community.

We offer anonymous HIV/AIDS testing to walk-in patients that gives results in 20 minutes.

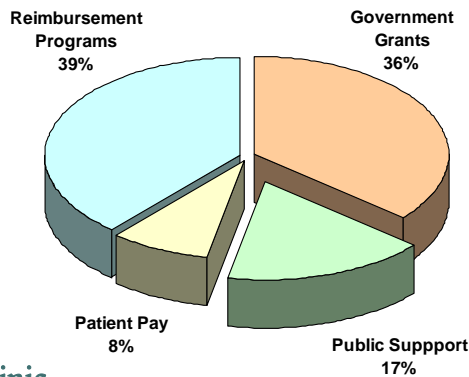

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Funding Sources

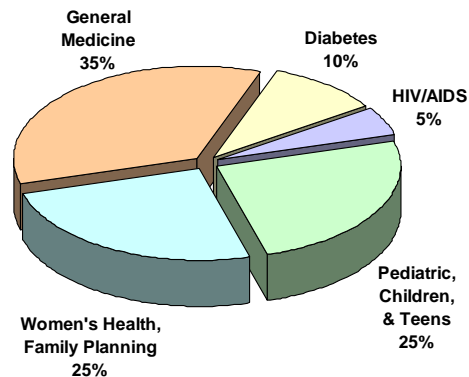
